ADVANCED IRRIGATION WIRING METHODS & TROUBLESHOOTING - 8 CECs

Instructor: Craig Borland

This full day session will cover different types of transformers, proper phasing (primary and secondary), diagnosing problems using different meters, wire sizing for communication cables and two-wire systems, DC controllers, special solenoids and proper splicing techniques.

LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION TECHNICIAN COURSE- 8 CECs - *Water Conservation*

Instructor: Craig Borland

This Irrigation Association course is for contractors new to the landscape irrigation industry. Students will become familiar with landscape sprinkler system components and terminology and understand the basics of system component installation. This course also serves as a review for those taking the Certified Irrigation Technician exam.

IMPORTANT: The Certified Irrigation Technician (CIT) EXAM is a separate component of the course. *THERE IS AN ADDITIONAL COST FOR THE EXAM.* You can register to take the Wednesday class only to earn CECs; however, if you plan to take the exam, you must register and pay an additional \$175 (exam fee) on the IA site (Irrigation Association – National organization who oversees this certification). The CIT Exam will be given on Thursday, August 10th from 8:00am-12:00pm in the same location and will only be open to those who have pre-registered at the link below. ALTERNATIVE WATER FOR LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION – 4 CECs – *Water Conservation*

FOUNDATIONS OF LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION DESIGN

16 CECs – 8 are Water Conservation, 8 are General

Instructor: Bill Wise

Master the basics of irrigation design. Developed by IA instructors with years of teaching experience, this beginner reference focuses on designing a simple residential or small commercial system. Organized to follow the typical design process, topics include gathering site information, calculating system capacity, soil-water-plant relationships, pipe sizing, hydraulics, head layout, uniformity, zoning and plan presentation. This course has been completely refreshed and offers 16 credits including 8 in water conservation.

IRRIGATION SCHEDULING - 4 CECs – Water Conservation

This class covers the methods used to predict and estimate water usage and to enable irrigation professionals the ability to provide the stakeholder/owner with the critical information needed to operate the irrigation system efficiently and to schedule according to water restrictions imposed due to water supply issues and/or drought conditions (designated day watering), and scheduling based upon soil-water-plant needs (soil water availability).

DRIPLINE INSTALLATION: DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS AND METHODS FOR VARIOUS SITUATIONS - 4 CECs

This course is for beginner to intermediate contractors/installers and will cover planting beds as well as hedges, hills and turf. Learn the design basics and how to correctly program by soil type, intake rate and root depth.
