Requires installation of operational automatic rain sensor or smart sprinkler as condition of sale of certain real properties, and on certain commercial, retail, and industrial properties and common interest communities within specified timeframes.

- 1. Section 1 of P.L.2000, c.107 (C.52:27D-123.13) is amended to read as follows:
- 1. <u>a.</u> An automatic lawn sprinkler system installed after [the effective date of P.L.2000, c.107 (C.52:27D-123.13)] September 8, 2000 shall be equipped with an <u>operational</u> automatic rain sensor [device or switch that will override the irrigation cycle of the automatic lawn sprinkler system when adequate rainfall has occurred] or a smart sprinkler.
- 17 b. ³[(1) Every contract of sale of real property upon which an automatic lawn sprinkler system was installed on or prior to 18 September 8, 2000 shall include a provision requiring, as a 19 condition of the sale, the installation of an operational automatic 20 21 rain sensor ¹ [device or switch that will override the irrigation cycle 22 of the automatic lawn sprinkler system when adequate rainfall has occurred or a smart sprinkler or the deposit of monies in escrow 23 in an amount sufficient to cover the costs of the installation of an 24 operational automatic rain sensor or a smart sprinkler². 25
 - (2) Closing of title on the sale of any real property shall not occur unless documentation is provided demonstrating the installation of an operational automatic rain sensor ¹[device or switch] or smart sprinkler ¹ or the deposit of monies in escrow ² as required by paragraph (1) of this subsection. At closing, the buyer and seller both shall certify in writing that the requirements of this subsection have been met.
